Fundraising Takes Off



Development Plan gets go-ahead

We have been talking about it for months. The Poppleton Centre is out of space. We need to add more rooms. It's been months in the making, and it'll be many more months coming to fruition, but the plans to enlarge The Poppleton Centre have now been approved by City of York Council and the fundraising starts in earnest.

£460,000 Target

Cost estimates have put the whole project at £800,000 with the result that the plan has been split into three phases.

Phase 1 - Adding two rooms on a first floor above the Maypole and Dodsworth Rooms, with sprung floors, to accommodate many regular and potential new users. Access will be through external doors, stairs and a lift. A small kitchen and toilets will be included on the first floor. Estimated cost £260,000.

Phase 2 - Enlarging Poppleton Social to provide additional seating, new roofing, bifold doors to create improved access to outside seating and improved kitchen facilities. It will also provide a smaller meeting room which will be used as a much needed home for Poppleton United to use as their base on Saturday afternoons following their matches. Estimated cost $\pounds200,000$

Phase 3 - Creating extra space to enable Explore Library to move from its current location to The Centre. Estimated cost £330,000.

Trust Pledges £150,000

Poppleton Community Trust, which manages The Centre on behalf of the villages, has pledged £100,000 from existing funds and hopes to generate a further £50,000 from fundraising events. We look forward to welcoming you to these and hope that you'll take the opportunity to bring family and friends along, too.

The proposed solar farm will cover **125** acres with an expected generating capacity of up to **34 megawatts**. We anticipate the solar farm will be able to supply the electricity needs of approximately **12,400 homes**. The clean energy generated will **save on average 12,900 tonnes of carbon** per year and the project will also help to support **City of York Council's net zero carbon ambitions**.

The solar farm will be temporary, with an operational period of circa 30 years. At the end of its lifespan, the site will be decommissioned, and the land returned to full agricultural use, with improved soil quality.

We are mindful of the existing environmental context of the site, and the solar farm has been designed to protect public footpaths, local views, and avoid disruption to the local community where possible.

We are looking at ways to help ensure Poppleton benefits from the development of the solar farm.

We are consulting on our proposals and our consultation is running from **4 July 2023 to 28 July 2023.** It is an opportunity for the local community to shape our proposals before we submit a planning application later this year. We will be holding a **drop in event at The Poppleton Centre (YO26 6JT) on Wednesday 12 July 2023, from 12 (midday) to 7pm.** Please come along to find out more about our proposals and to ask the project team any questions.
